General tennis terms:

- Forehand - stroke used to return balls on racquet side of body
- Backhand - stroke used to return balls on non-racquet side of body
- Rally - a series of strokes made between players during the play for a point
- Let ball - served ball that touches the net AND lands in the proper court
- Volley - a stroke made by hitting the ball before it has touched the ground
- Foot fault - stepping on/over the line before hitting the ball in a serve
- Lob - a ball that is hit high in the air
- Singles - 2 participants (one player against the other)
- Doubles - 4 participants (two against two)
- Service - to put the ball into play

Scoring:

- Love - no point
- 15-1 $1^{\text {st }}$ point
- $30-2^{\text {nd }}$ point
- $40-3^{\text {rd }}$ point
- Game-4 $4^{\text {th }}$ point
- Deuce - when both sides have 3 points (40)
- No ad scoring - when the winner of the deuce point wins the game
- Ad scoring - when games must be won by 2 consecutive points
- Ad in - when the server wins the deuce point
- Ad out - when the server loses the deuce point
- Set - when one team wins 6 games (by a margin of two games... up to 6-6)
- Tie breaker - played when a set is tied at 6-6.
- Match -2 out of 3 sets (typically in girls/womens tennis)
